



**SECTION 3000 - STUDENTS
HONOUR ROLL**

Schools in the division use the Honour Roll system to recognize student academic accomplishment. The following guideline shall determine the Honour Roll in Grades Nine through Twelve:

- “Honours” is achieved with a minimum overall average of 80%, based on all courses, with no mark less than 65%.
- “Honours with Distinction” is achieved with a minimum overall average of 90%, based on all courses, with no mark less than 70%.
- Honour Roll is determined at the completion of the course. For Grade Nine students, Honour Roll will be recognized in June. For students in Grade Ten through Grade Twelve, Honour Roll is determined at the completion of each semester. Students must be enrolled in a minimum of four courses in a semester to qualify.
- At graduation, “Honours” is calculated by averaging the marks in the top five courses taken at the Grade Twelve level, in three different subject areas. English and Mathematics must be two of the courses utilized in the calculation. Any courses taken during the student’s graduating year must be above 65%.

The Lord Selkirk School Division shall make the Honour Roll public.
